Quorum present and meeting called to order at 10:08 am at Mike Kotila's home.

Treasurer's Report: Laura reported the balance at \$10494.53. Funds are being transferred to Home State Bank with minimum retained at Wells Fargo to close the account. Any dues received prior to the annual meeting will be held for fiscal new year (July 1). Laura will investigate non-profit status with Paypal, which should reduce the fees. **MOTION to approve Treasurer's Report by Dick N, second by R Newman, all in favor.**

Old Business:

- Mary N was on hand to discuss updating the homepage with current information and news. Will introduce the cookbook project, and create a weather/lake statistics page.
- Brenda K discussed the plan for this year's Jennie Gear. Limited editions with a July 10 deadline for donations free gear. - Randy N and Dick N to continue water testing and secchi readings.
- Update on Terracing project: Paul Virnig has confirmed that we have up to \$8500 in grants available for our prevention projects.
- DNR Report: Randy Nass noted new staff Timothy Plude, AIS and Scott Mackenthun, fisheries. Will contact each of them to invite to speak at our annual meeting. The association was provided with 3 zebra mussel trackers for the AIS monitoring program and were distributed to board members Dick N, Mark T and Laura O, and Randy Newman. Meeker County Lakes to band together to determine action plans for AIS. Concerns about inspection services, especially during fishing tournaments. Volunteers are needed to assist at the landing. They can ask to inspect but have no authority to prevent launch. They can contact the conservation office or the sheriff's office. Garbage issues continue at the South landing, but no success in investigating the culprit yet.
- The newsletter is slated to go out this week.
- Mailing for the annual dues donations will go out asap. Dues approved at \$50, t-shirt at \$100 and a sweatshirt at \$500. Donors are requested to contact Brenda K by July 10 for free gear
