Area Services by Laura Osborne

Happy Fall! We thought it might be nice to include some information on services available to us here around Lake Jennie, for those who are new to our area, as well as those who may be looking to change.

INTERNET SERVICE – I will use 50 mbps as an example, this should be enough to stream several devices at one time.

Xtratyme - owned by one of our own here on Lake Jennie, offers service both seasonal and year round. Packages start at \$15/month, and is based on usage. For the 50 Mbps, the rate is \$89.97/ month. There are no fees, data caps or contracts. Most will receive a small mounted radio that faces one of several towers around the area. Weather should not cause any interference, but branches blowing may. You can control your internet speed by logging in and changing speeds at any time, response time is generally 15 minutes or less. They also offer additional upload/download speed for virtual meetings for an additional \$10/month.

Vibrant - owned and operated through Meeker Cooperative, also offers a seasonal package, up to 6 months for \$15/month. If you power cameras, smart thermostats, or the like, rates are \$22/month. For the 50 Mbps, the rate is \$70/month. They offer fiber direct to select areas (West side) and line of sight fixed wireless to others. They offer an individual signal for each customer, and say that there is no weather interference. Last check, installation is free to members of Meeker Coop.

Nuvera - service availability varies by address. They are currently installing fiber direct along the West side of the lake, with plans to do the South and Southeast areas in the future. (Currently will remain on copper) They also offer a seasonal/vacation rate, with no charge to suspend the service, but a reconnect fee will be charged. There is no installation charge with a 2 year contract, but there is a \$45 truck fee that cannot be waived. Their package offers a 55 Mbps for \$74.95/month for the copper, upgrades to 60 Mbps for fiber and is \$84.95/month.

Garbage Service- I priced a 65 gallon can for comparison purposes.

West Central Sanitation- a family owned business based out of Willmar, offers a seasonal option for a minimum of 5 months. If you prepay (\$100/yr.), you can set the dates, and they will automatically bring the can and start service for dates requested. There are no contracts, charges are \$19.08/month, billed quarterly. They do charge a \$50 deposit that is applied to your first bill.

Mumford Sanitation – Family owned business based in Howard Lake, offers both seasonal and year round service, there is no minimum for seasonal, you can choose when you want services for the same rate. No contract or deposit is required. Charges are \$24.15/month, and is billed quarterly.

Waste Management – referred me to the website. Also does not require a contract, billing is \$23.57/ month. Promotional free delivery and setup if you order service online.
