Weed Study:

Limnopro wanted to do a study. Is this in the budget for next year? Should we do a cheaper weed option and apply twice at 1 per 5 acres? LJIA will do the sampling instead of Limnopro. The total will be around \$13,000, of which \$8,000 will be ours and \$5,000 from the grant. This includes the nutriment weed study and equipment for LJIA. Mike Kotila will investigate further and send something out before November 1, 2019.

MOTION to approve up to \$13,000 budget. All in favor. Passed.
