MCAL Report:

Grants:

The MCAL board (Kim and George) will review and make decisions in early December.

County Meeting:

Randy Newman attended the MCAL meeting. Lake Manuella and Koronis Lake are using Diquat. There is a list of lakes that are not permitted to use Diquat and Lake Jennie is on this list. Determine how we can get off this list. Clear Lake (by Watkins) has a weed harvester and the DNR is permitting them to use it. Clear Lake Association dues were \$1 per foot for lake residents.

AIS Grant:

Mike Kotila completed and submitted the grants. Thank you, Mike. LJIA submitted for \$12,500. LJIA will contribute \$12,500. Proposing the DNR will contribute \$5,000 for a total of \$30,000. 470 acres maximum but limited to 25% by law.

Limnopro had four suggestions in their report. The report includes areas of curly leaf and the cost to treat it. The maximim grant is \$12,500 with a one to one match. Last year we got \$5,000 from the DNR.
